The International Cruise Victims Association (ICV) is pleased to announce they have applied for Non-Governmental Organization status (NGO) with the International Maritime Organization (IMO). The IMO is a Specialized agency of the United Nations.

ICV was founded over ten years ago by victims of crime on cruise ships with a goal of improving safety and security for all passengers. Since that time, the ICV membership base has evolved to include maritime and security experts as well as other extremely accomplished individuals who serve on the Board of Directors in one or more of the organizations corporations located in the U.S., the UK and Australia.

With membership in 35 countries around the world; the organization's all-volunteer staff has no business interests—only the safety and security of the 21 million people who are projected to be cruising per year currently.

ICV, being fully recognized by Congress in the US House and Senate as valuable towards this aim, has been called to testify in Congressional hearings on eight separate occasions. In 2010, their expertise resulted in the passage of a bill known as the Cruise Vessel Safety and Security Act. This legislation, the first of its kind anywhere throughout the globe, is dedicated solely to improving cruise passenger safety. ICV hopes to lend similar expert value and function to the IMO when called upon to do so.
